ROME'S CONQUEST vied for the lead up the backstretch, continued in aim around the turn, rebroke in the upper stretch, took over the lead a furlong out, edged away and held late. SPRINT OUT PASS was well reserved and trailed in the back, shifted to the far outside at the head of the lane, rallied strongly along the outside and closed on the winner. DEFENDING ALBERT raced off the top flight up the backstretch, launched a four wide bid in upper stretch, advanced to race in aim for the late lead then finished evenly. WHERE'S THE LOOT raced in the second flight up the backstretch, sat four paths wide late on the turn, hustled along into the lane and had a mild improve. TRIPLE UP raced off the pace, swung three wide into the lane and improved without threatening. AL'S ROMEO dueled up the backstretch, continued to battle into the lane, failed to match strides in the final furlong and gave way. KOSARI raced off the top flight in the opening quarter, hustled along two wide into the lane and failed to move on. LEGACY ACCOUNT vied inside of rivals up the backstretch and around the turn then came up tired in the lane.
