BLOW TORCH rated off the early pace, edged closer two wide late on the turn, tipped three wide at the head of the lane, took over the lead at the sixteenth pole and edged clear. AXEL STEEL vied for the early lead, shook clear at the quarter pole, led the way into the lane, got collared by the winner at the sixteenth pole and finished second best. RIVER RIDGE settled off the early pace, launched a bid along the rail at the head of the lane, advanced to race in aim a furlong out then yielded late. HOLIDAY HOUSE tracked the top pair up the backstretch, hustled along four wide into upper stretch and ran on for a minor share. EL SARGENTO raced off the early pace and lacked a needed rally. BOLT FORTY FIVE dueled up the match stretch, could not match strides approaching the quarter pole and gave way. TZEDAKAH raced near midpack in early stages then steadily retreated.
