BURN INDY BURN held a slim lead under pressure up the backstretch and around the turn, widened in hand turning for home, tapped once right handed approaching the eighth pole then pulled away while ridden out. KILLIAN pressed the pace in the opening quarter, continued to force the issue around the turn, was no match for the eventual winner at the head of the lane but kept on for second best. PREACHER MAN SAM settled just off the early pace, made a move three wide around the turn, ran on down the lane and secured a share. TIME TO SING raced in range up the backstretch, entered the turn two wide then took the inside path near the quarter pole, ran on just off the inside in upper stretch and flattened in the final furlong. MY RAPHA waited for a clear path under a snug hold early along the inside, flattened upon entering the turn, came under a ride, tipped two wide for the drive and had no punch. CASH'S PAL stumbled badly at the start and lost the rider, ran loose behind the field, was caught in the stretch and walked off.
