TRUE JEDI tracked the early pace, advanced to challenge at the quarter pole, took over the lead turning for home and kept clear. SAY IT NICELY set a pressured pace, took on the challenge from the winner at the quarter pole, got collared for the lead bur ran on down teh lane and held place. ALLO ENRY raced near midpack in the early going, hustled along two wide past the quarter pole, sustained a steady bid and captured a share. GAMBLER ROCKET raced off the pace, came under a rode four wide at the head of the lane and improved. HURTS SO GOOD pressed the early pace, hustled along two wide into the lane and ran on evenly late. IN THE MIX saved ground along the inside, chased mid-range to the furlong marker then gave way. AUX ARCS raced off the pace two to three wide and failed to threaten. NINETEEN HUNDRED broke out at the start and showed little. NEBRASKA GOLD was forwardly placed, continued in contention around the turn then faded in the lane.
