DESPERATE MAN vied inside of BEAU DAY up the backstretch and into the turn, shook free past the quarter pole, hustled along two wide into the lane and held clear. INDIAN CAT tracked the early pace, hustled along approaching the quarter pole, ran on three wide down the lane and gained place. I GOT NO MUNNY raced in range along the inside, cut the corner entering the top of the stretch, hustled along the rail, advanced behind the leader then yielded late and held show. DONTBESOOGRUCHY raced off the early pace, hustled along four wide around the turn, kept under a ride outside down the lane and just missed show. BEAU DAY vied outside of the winner up the backstretch and around the turn, could not match strides turning for home but ran on with response then flattened late. SEEKING SAWYER hopped awkwardly at the start and came away slowly, spotted the field five lengths, saved ground in the back, ran on two wide down the lane and never threatened.
