FREE DROP TABBY settled and saved ground up the backstretch, shifted to the four path at the head of the lane, given cue, responded and edged clear late. LONELY WOMAN vied three wide up the backstretch, shook free with three furlongs left to run, remained clear into the final furlong then got overtaken late. HIGH CLASS LADY raced off the top flight, picked up the pace mid-way around the turn, hustled along two wide down the lane and cleared a share. IRISH LASS was allowed to settle early, circled up into contention at the quarter pole, ran on three wide into upper stretch and flattened late. BACK NINE raced off the early pace, hustled along three wide at the head of the lane and lacked a rally. OVERTHROW raced in or near the back, swung four wide into the lane and failed to threaten. DEVIL'S DEN hustled up out of the gate and vied for the early lead, could not match strides past the three eighths pole and steadily faded. TENNIS BRACELET dueled between rivals up the backstretch then steadily retreated.
