MIDSHAKIN was forwardly placed up the backstretch, advanced to challenge NET PROFIT for the lead approaching the quarter pole, shook clear in upper stretch and kept to task under steady encouragement. JESTER SANG tracked inside through early stages, angled out two wide around the turn, launched three wide bid at the head of the lane, ran on and cleared second best. TARTARIAN was allowed to settle in the opening quarter, headed in pursuit mid-way around the turn, swung four paths wide entering the head of the lane and ran on for a share. NET PROFIT bobbed at the start then took over the early lead, led the way by a slim margin in the opening quarter, took on the challenge from MIDSHAKIN nearing the quarter pole, got collared for the lead entering the head of the lane gave way. DENALI LIGHTNING prompted the pace up the backstretch, weakened around the turn and continued to tired in the drive.
