CAJUN HOTTIE set the early pace, held clear around the turn, saved ground turning for home and kept to task. MSPUNKINSPEREGRINE tracked the early leader, hustled along two to three wide into the lane and secured second best. RIDE raced off the early pace, saved ground around the turn, sustained an inside bid down the lane and prevailed for a share. ANTE UP TONY lagged briefly after the start then gained position up the backstretch, swung two to three wide into the lane and had a mild improve. IDES OF DEMARCH raced just off midpack in the opening quarter, hustled along three to four wide into the upper stretch and lacked the needed response for serious impact. UNASSUMING tracked the top pair up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn then gave way. LET'S RACE UHH HUH raced near mid-range, had no response around the turn and dropped back in the lane. SWEAT hopped in air and stumbled on the way down, never recovered and raced in the back thoroughout.
