LAST DIAMOND set a pressured pace up the backstretch, shook free around the turn, came two wide into the upper stretch, sustained response and held clear. COPPER ECHO rated just off the early pace, waited briefly with three furlongs left to run, made a move two wide mid-way around the turn, was set down four wide for the drive, responded willingly and gained to the wire. SALTHAWK vied with the eventual winner up the backstretch, remained forwardly placed two wide around the turn, ran on into the lane and prevailed for a share. MILTON STREET vied up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, hustled along the inside into the lane, took closer order then flattened late. STROLLER BOY raced in or near the back, swung five wide into the lane and lacked a needed rally. SURPRISE ROAD TRIP sat just off the early pace, moved up closer near the quarter pole, ran on into upper stretch then weakened in the final furlong.
