WAR BOY drifted out sharply at the start, angled back to the inside and hustled up along the rail, waited for a clear path around the turn, found a seam along the inside in the final furlong, inched way up to gain the late lead and held on. KEARNEY STREET tracked the pace up the backstretch, launched a three wide bid at the head of the lane, advanced into striking distance, continued to inch up closer to the wire and just missed. MISTER J. P. set the pace, held firm around the turn, came two wide into upper stretch, kept on gamely under pressure from both sides then got denied late. STONE MAN was stubborn to load, sat just off the early pace, hustled along four wide at the head of the lane and lacked closing response. KIND SOUL got bumped slightly by the eventual winner just out of the gate, was forwardly placed up the backstretch, flattened two wide late on the turn and had no late response. SKIPPED A BEAT was forced to taken up at the start when the winner drifted out, raced in the back and failed to move into contention. STEWARDS POSTED INQUIRY LOOKING AT THE START, AFTER REVIEW NO ACTION WAS TAKEN
