VINO VIDA sped to the lead at the start, set the early pace then vied inside of GALVANIZER at the quarter pole, shook free entering the head of the lane, roused flor more, responded willingly, had plenty left in reserve and finished going away. MYJERSEYSAYSGOOD raced mid-pack in the opening quarter, launched a three wide bid late on the turn, ran on with response and gained second best. NO FREE KISSES was allowed to settle in early stages, saved ground around the turn, sustained a bid along the inside and narrowly missed place. GALVANIZER was forwardly placed up the backstretch, vied with the eventual winner going by the quarter pole, could not match strides at the head of the lane and weakened mid-stretch. ADDED TIME raced off the early pace, swung four wide into upper stretch and lacked a needed rally. FALLEN STAR was off slow at the start, raced in the back, saved ground and never threatened. KING GEORGE edged up closer along the rail, steadied slightly near the half mile marker then got in tight quarters and had to be taken up sharply entering the turn, lost all momentum, dropped back and never recovered. PRINCE AND PENNY was forwardly placed up the backstretch then steadily weakened around the turn.
