MILTON STREET set the early pace, held clear around the turn, saved ground turning for home, widened under steady encouragement and kept to task. SURPRISE ROAD TRIP raced just off midpack in the opening quarter, waited briefly along the inside, angled out mid-way around the turn, set down four wide at the head of the lane, angled in two wide and finished with good response. UNCLE SINGH tracked the top trio up the backstretch, hustled along three wide around the turn and ran on for a share. STROLLER BOY raced off the early pace, was ridden four wide around the turn and lacked a needed rally. EYE OF THE PANTHOR trailed in the opening quarter, saved ground around the turn and never threatened. FREEDOM TO SPEED was forwardly placed up the backstretch, sustained bid around the turn then gave way. SHUT UP MAN showed brief response in the opening quarter then retreated.
