WOODSPOINT cleared the lead soon after the start then came under some pressure from outside running UNCLE TATER, edged away to a clearer lead and held firm still unleashed around the turn, came two wide into the head of the lane, given cue, responded gamely, widened advantage and kept to task. TRAFALGAR'S HERO tracked the pace between foes in early early stages, roused for more three wide near the quarter pole, sustained a solid effort down the lane but had to settle for second best. TIZ HAPPY saved ground up the backstretch, gained closer contention late on the turn, given cue along the rail at the head of the lane, ranged up into close range then yielded in the final sixteenth. SPUNOUTOFMYMIND raced in range through early stages, hustled along four wide into the stretch and ran on evenly. UNCLE TATER prompted the early pace, continued to chase after the eventual winner around the turn then gave way. CONWAY saved ground and raced in the back throughout. Times unavailable pending review This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times.
