FIVE CHARLIE dueled for the lead up the backstretch and into the turn, shook free past the quarter pole, came two wide into upper stretch, roused for more, responded, dug in and held firm. OLE MIKEY BAGELS tracked the early pace, saved ground around the turn, came under a ride along the rail at the head of the lane and gained second best. RAZOR WIRE raced off the early pace, advanced into closer contention near the quarter pole, sustained a steady outside bid down the lane and secured a share. ORPHAN SANDY was slightly awkward at the start, raced off the early pace, urged near the inside in the stretch and had a mild improve. MEEKER tracked the early pace, chased two wide around the turn then flattened out. PALACE ROCK raced in the back, swung wide into the lane and failed to threaten. BIG MAN STAN dueled up the backstretch and into the turn, could not match strides with eventual winner past the quarter pole and gave way.
