DRESS GOOD raced near mid-pack in early stages, picked up the pace two wide around the turn, challenged MUBAREZ for the lead in upper stretch, got a head in front at the furlong marker, cleared command then yielded late, came under strong left handed urging and held on. MUBAREZ was off a step slow at the start, angled inside and took over the lead near the half mile marker, held firm around the turn, took on the challenge from stable-mate in upper stretch, got collared at the eighth pole, dug back in gamely and edged closer in final strides. STILLBILLY raced off the early pace, hustled along four wide into the head of the lane, sustained a steady bid and cleared a share. KING IN THE NORTH led the way in opening stages, got collared near the half mile marker, weakened late on the turn, shifted out wider at the head of the lane, ran on and passed a couple of faders. COMPREHEND saved ground around the turn, showed some brief interest in upper stretch then flattened out. LEDBETTER was forwardly placed in the opening quarter, chased three wide around the turn then weakened in the lane.
