KING ADOLIS was forwardly placed around the first turn, vied up the backstretch, cleared the lead entering the far turn, stayed wide down the lane and pulled away. RIDING DOUBLE settled through early stages, took closer order around the far turn, shifted to the inside of wide winner and cleared second best. ASK ARTHUR raced off the early pace, urged three to four wide into the lane and cleared a share. SAND PAYNTER led the way around the first turn, vied up the backstretch, failed to move on with eventual winner around the far turn and steadily weakened. MASH ON THE GAS was reserved in the back and passed tiring foes in the lane. EASY MUNNINGS tracked the early pace near the inside, chased around the turn then steadily faded. BUREAUCRATIC raced off the pace and failed to move into contention. BATTLE CRUISER raced in range through early stages, hustled along the far turn then gave way.
