VANDOR was away in good order and angled in from the outside post to challenge RUB OF THE GREEN for the early lead, held a slim lead two wide around the turn, ran on into the lane, dug in gamely under steady urging and held late. KEARNEY STREET came away in good order, raced up close two wide and steadied when VANDOR angled in to take the two path in early stages, briefly lost momentum then moved up close close three wide around the turn, sustained bid for VANDOR into the lane, dug in two wide under firm handling and failed to get by the winner. MISCHIEVOUS AL tracked the top trio in early stages, edged closer four wide late on the turn, ran on into the lane and prevailed for show. K B'S STREET got carried in at the start, chased the pace along the inside, hustled along two wide into the upper stretch and needed more for late impact. RUB OF THE GREEN vied for the early lead with VANDOR, chased up close along the inside around the turn then weakened in the lane. VINO VIDA was briefly stubborn to load, drifted in at the start, lacked speed and had no response when called upon. SKIPPED A BEAT raced off the pace, swung five wide into the lane and never threatened.
