MERASOL SUGAR stalked the pace through early stages, advanced to engage duo for the lead at the half mile marker, cleared the lead mid-way around the far turn, was set down two wide for the drive, held clear a furlong out, appeared all out late, ran on gamely and just lasted. TRIPLE UP tracked the pace up the backstretch, took closer order near the quarter pole, hustled along three wide into the drive, dug in determinedly, steadily edged up closer and just missed. BAXTER settled through early stages, picked up the pace late on the far turn, hustled along four wide into the lane and produced a solid finish. SPRINT OUT PASS raced off the early pace, made way through traffic around the far turn, was ridden two wide then along the inside down the lane, raced in contention then yielded late. GOLD GUNNER raced up close around the first turn, dueled up the backstretch, could not move on with the winner near the mid-way point around the far turn and steadily weakened. LIL SCREECHER led the way around the first turn, dueled up the backstretch then gave way around the far turn.
