KING NIQUE took over the lead soon after the start, set the early pace and held firm around the turn, came two wide into upper stretch, responded willingly when called upon, was tapped once right handed in the final furlong and drew off. INDIAN CAT raced off the early pace, saved ground around the turn, launched a two wide bid at the head of the lane and captured place. CAUTION CARDINAL tracked the leader up the backstretch, was ridden along the inside around the turn, sustained a rail bid through the lane and lasted for show. I GOT NO MUNNY raced off the top trio into the turn, hustled along three wide into upper stretch and just missed show. C R INSTA GATOR was forwardly placed in early stages, continued up close around the turn then gave way in the final furlong. LAST DIAMOND raced off the pace, swung four to five wide into the lane and failed to threaten. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times.
