SHEZAWILDSTORM vied for the lead around the first turn, up the backstretch and around the far turn, dug in gamely, shook free entering the head of the lane and finished going away. BAMTWENTYKLATER dueled between rivals around the first turn, up the backstretch and battled on around the final turn, could not move on with eventual winner at the head of the lane but kept on and just lasted for place. ESPERANZA'S SPIRIT raced in contention around the first turn and tracked the pace up the backstretch, hustled along four wide mid-way around the final turn, sustained bid through the lane and narrowly missed place. PRINCIPAL ANITA was forwardly placed around the first turn, vied three deep up the backstretch, battled on around the far turn, could not match strides with the eventual winner at the head of the lane and flattened to a minor share. LADY OF DEVON settled and saved ground through early stages, cut the corner entering the upper stretch, briefly gained closer contention along the rail near the furlong marker then failed to sustain bid and weakened. JERI DAWN was well reserved and trailed in the back, swung three to four wide into the upper stretch and failed to threaten. WHAT ABOUT Q settled through early stages, picked up the pace late on the backstretch, raced in range, urged four to five wide near the quarter pole, failed to kick on then faded in the lane. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
