KOSARI chased between foes in a compact flight in the opening quarter, hustled along three paths wide into the upper stretch, steadily edged up closer, urged right handed twice, responded determinedly and got a nose up on the wire. VALE broke sharp, cleared and crossed over to the inside, held firm around the turn, saved ground turning for home, stayed inside, battled on under firm right handed pressure and got caught in final stride. DAWSON'S STORM tracked the leader in the opening quarter, continued in contention around the turn, hustled along two paths wide into the upper stretch, sustained a steady bid and held show. ROCKIN THE DAD BOD raced inside in a compact flight in early stages, cut the corner entering the head of the lane, sustained steady bid along the inside and got edged late for show. GLUCKSTADT raced in the back, swung wide into the stretch and showed some mild interest in final stages. BIYOMBO raced in a compact flight in early stages, chased four wide around the turn and faded in the lane. ON A HUNCH chased between foes in the opening quarter, hustled along two wide around the turn then retreated in the lane.
