KISSED A CADET tracked the early pace, waited inside around the turn, tipped three wide for the drive, given cue leaving the furlong marker and edged away. BURN INDY BURN was forwardly placed up the backstretch, advanced to challenge at the quarter pole, led the way into late stages then got overtaken by the winner. NATIVE HELLRAISER raced off the early pace, saved ground around the turn, launched a two wide in upper stretch and gained show. MY RAPHA set the early pace, took on the challenge of BURN INDY BURN at the quarter pole, got collared for the lead and gave way. STEELY EYE raced off the pace, urged three to four wide at the quarter pole and failed to respond. PREACHER MAN SAM acted up at the start and came away slowly, trailed in early stages and failed to move into contention.
