WHITING FIELD sped to the lead soon after the start and held clear around the first turn, set the pace while saving ground up the backstretch, took on the bid from DOUBLECHECK mid-way around the turn and edged clear leaving the quarter pole, saved ground entering the head of the lane, widened advantage in the upper stretch, came under firm handling in late stages and held off a determined bid from BOUGIE JOE. BOUGIE JOE was allowed to settle out of the gate and remained unhurried up the backstretch, gained along the rail around the far turn then shifted out three wide entering the head of the lane, came under right handed encouragement, responded, closed on the winner but had to settle for clearly second best. DOUBLECHECK was forwardly placed around the first turn and up the backstretch, moved up to challenge WHITING FIELD for the lead mid-way around the far turn, could not move on with eventual winner past the quarter pole, ran on with response to mid-stretch then weakened and just lasted for show. BUREAUCRATIC was unhurried and raced in the back, saved ground around the far turn, came under a ride along the rail at the head of the lane and narrowly missed show. ICE AGAIN stalked the top two leaders up the backstretch, roused for more around the far turn, had no response and steadily weakened. MOVE IN SILENCE was off a step slow then bobbled just after and lost momentum, raced off the pace along the outside, had no response when called upon around the far turn and dropped back in the lane.
