LADY RILEY pressed the pace in opening stages, vied with MARITIME MILLIE around the turn, continued to duel and brushed with aforementioned rival in the upper stretch, briefly lost some momentum then set back down three to four wide, responded gamely and edged clear late. BLISTER BUG prompted the pace in opening stages, then sat off the top pair around the turn, launched a bid along the rail at the head of the lane, dueled for the lead and got denied late. CLIMB TO GLORY sat just off midpack in early stages, advanced three wide around the turn, drifted in a a path and steadied slightly in upper stretch, lost some momentum, came under strong left handed urging, responded and finished with response. MARITIME MILLIE set a pressured early pace, dueled around the turn, took on added challengers in the lane and yielded late. CANKTON'S COWGIRL raced in range in early stages, then lacked room racing

between rivals and tugged wanting to go near the quarter pole, continued behind a wall of rivals in the upper stretch, got clear two wide near the eighth pole and responded evenly. FLOATING raced near midpack, coaxed four wide around the turn, swung wide into the lane, angled in a couple paths and lacked a needed rally. SHESACINCH raced off the early pace, swung wide into the upper stretch and failed to threaten. PEGGY RULES saved ground along the inside, tipped two wide for the drive and had no response when called upon. YOGURT raced off the pace, chased three wide around the turn, spun four to five wide into the drive and never threatened. ANNIEWAY U WANT IT raced off the early pace along the outside, swung widest into the lane and faded.
