HEY BUDDY was forwardly placed around the first turn, advanced and dueled between rivals up the backstretch, held a slight edge over COME ON MULITCH late on the far turn, saved ground turning for home, widened advantage under steady pressure and kept clear. STEAM POWERED was forced to steady and and go wide around troubled foe after entering the first turn, lost ground, steadily picked up the pace upon entering the backstretch and raced off the embattled trio with a half mile left to run, made a three wide move mid-way around the far turn, sustained bid into the lane, raced in striking range of HEY BUDDY, failed to reach firm holding winner and settled for clearly second best. COME ON MULITCH advanced leaving the first turn and dueled outside of a duo up the backstretch, battled on with HEY BUDDY late on the far turn, weakened off the top pair down the lane while remaining clear over the rest. TOMS PROSPECTOR led the way around the first turn then quickly took on challengers entering the backstretch, dueled inside a duo then came up empty around the far turn and steadily retreated. OLIVERIO steadied and forced to wide to go around trouble rival around the first turn, raced in range up the backstretch, coaxed four wide around the far turn, failed to progress when called upon and dropped back in the lane. LORD DIAMOND took an awkward step and quickly pulled up around the first turn, was transported via equine ambulance after the race.
