MISCHIEVOUS AL was well placed sitting just off the embattled top flight in opening stages, let out a notch and advanced two wide mid-way around the turn, sustained two wide bid into the upper stretch, dug in under firm handling, got a head past GALVANIZER late then just lasted over late surging runner up. IKNOWAGUY lunged at the start and came away slowly, trailed up the backstretch and remained reserved saving ground around the turn, tipped three wide in the upper stretch, given cue, kicked in gamely, surged to the wire and denied a nose for the win. GALVANIZER set a pressured pace in opening stages, held a slim lead around the turn, dug in along the inside trying to hold off MISCHIEVOUS AL in the stretch run, got collared for the late lead then fought back gamely along the rail and just missed. WITCH WAYDIDHEGO tracked the top flight in opening stages, sat just off the leader around the turn, hustled along three paths wide into the upper stretch, raced in striking distance then yielded late. VINO VIDA vied in opening stages, flattened around the turn then ran on evenly down the lane. BOUNDINGS MISCHIEF sat off the early pace while never far back, raced four wide late on the turn, urged along the outside entering the upper stretch and failed to kick on. FIFTH SUNDAY vied for the lead in opening stages, chased in contention around the turn then faded in the lane.
