KOSARI tracked the early pace, raced two wide going by the quarter pole, angled to the four path at the head of the lane, steadily edged up closer, dug in gamely three wide and got up late. LORD OF RHYMES set the early pace, dueled past the quarter pole, held a slim lead past the furlong marker, ran on gamely and got caught in final stride. GOLDEN LUNA was forwardly placed up the backstretch, vied late in the turn, continued to battle past leaving the furlong marker, could not match strides late but sustained a solid bid. MISSION BEACH raced off the early pace, hustled along five paths wide into the lane and finished with response. SEXAGENARIAN raced in early contention, advanced to race in aim for the lead late on the turn, continued in striking distance a furlong out then yielded late. MAVERAMA raced off the pace, swung six paths wide into the lane, showed interest but needed more. RIVERSIDE raced in the back, saved ground and failed to threaten.
