QUIETLINE settled through early stages, saved ground around the turn, angled out three wide in the lane and got up in final stride. STONE MAN was forwardly placed, moved up to challenge at the quarter pole, took over the lead a furlong out then got caught in final stride. VANDOR set the pace, vied with STONE MAN past the quarter pole, got headed for the lead a furlong out and ran on for show. CASH'S PAL tracked the early pace, hustled along three wide around the turn, continued in contention into the final furlong then ran on evenly. MACHO FORTY FIVE raced near midpack, was ridden along four wide going by the quarter pole, ran on into the lane but had no late punch. WAR BOY saved ground around the turn, angled out three wide for the drive and lacked a needed rally. BOUNDINGS MISCHIEF raced off the early pace, hustled along two paths wide late on the turn and failed to move on. BURN INDY BURN saved ground and failed to threaten.
