I LIKE IT BLACK hesitated and came away slowly at the start, was ridden up into contention, was keen early and tugged along wanting to do more while being rated, sat off the embattled top flight around the turn, lacked a clear path at the head of the lane, got clear three wide near mid-stretch, cleared at the sixteenth pole and finished going away, game effort. FOXTON vied for the lead up the backstretch and around the turn, continued to battle into the final furlong then got overtaken by the winner and had to settle for second best. GREASEPAINTGROUCHO dueled two wide between foes up the backstretch and around the turn, battled on with FOXTON into the final furlong then yielded late. NO FREE KISSES dueled three wide between foes up the backstretch and around the turn, could not move on with the top pair past upper stretch but kept on and narrowly missed show. MARGARITA TWOSDAY broke sharp, vied four deep up the backstretch and around the turn then weakened in the lane. FALLEN STAR raced off the early speed, saved ground into the lane and never threatened. READY TIME was not too far back early on, had no response when called upon around the turn and steadily faded. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time available.
