KISS THE TIGER had the rider lose the irons at the start, went to the lead with the rider sitting flat in the saddle and feet untethered, stayed in the two path, went a little wide on the last turn, yielded the lead, then came back on in the final yards to prevail in a remarkable effort. CHANCELLORS BOOM kept to a stalking position while saving ground, took the lead at the top of the stretch but hung and gave way in the final yards. PASS THE CROWN showed little interest early but kept trying and got up for third. QUICK BUCK tracked the top pair in third position, then lacked a late bid and yielded to a rival in the late stages.
