SAL N LOUIE raced off the pace inside, advanced inside, angled out midway on the far turn, rallied three wide into the stretch, wore down H C HOLIDAY and drew clear in the final sixteenth. H C HOLIDAY raced off the pace inside, made a four wide into contention on the far turn, led at the quarter pole, dug in

gamely in the stretch drive and then yielded grudgingly. SIR CUPID stalked between rivals, chased between horses on the far turn, rallied on the rail entering the stretch and bested the others for the show spot. WICKED GENIUS tracked on the inside, was shuffled back on the far turn, then closed mildly in the stretch. SAILOR'S RETURN was off slowly and checked, raced off the pace, moved up four wide run on the far turn and closed belatedly outside. DARVESH was outrun early and passed tired rivals. JIGSAW vied two wide for the lead, dueled, took over on the far turn, then faded entering the stretch. GRAND DANIEL raced off the pace inside, between rivals on the far turn and did not factor. ARAK raced off the rail, off the pace and faded. ARTISTIC REASON raced two wide off the pace and did not factor. MEGA CHARLIE vied inside for the lead, dueled and gave way. VENEZUELAN TRIUMPH raced five wide early, then stalked three wide, chased and gave way.
