MO SAYS controlled the pace off the inside then eagerly drew off in the stretch under moderate urging. THE CHALK saved ground, went after the winner on the turn and proved easily second best. CAPTAIN FANCY was urged just off the winner outside and faded in the stretch. HEPHEPCUTDOWNNETS raced wide on the turn then angled inside in the stretch. REELIN N DEALIN trailed far behind then passed fading rivals. CENTAUR CENTRAL settled behind pacesetters in two path and faded. AIRMAN TREVOR prompted the pace along the inside and gave way. VIX dropped back early and weakened steadily.
