BURNING EMBERS stalked two wide, bid on the turn, took charge, kicked clear and held sway late under urging. AMATERASU steadied in tight between rivals at the five and a half furlong marker, raced off the pace between rivals, rallied in the two path and was closed well late. CLOUT CHASER set the pace on the inside, dug in through the stretch drive and held for third. LULLABY LAND raced off the pace inside, raced three wide on the turn and gained mildly outside. PACIFIC PRINCESS raced off the rail, off the pace, went four wide on the turn and closed belatedly outside. BAD TEMPER stalked four wide early, then three wide, chased on the turn and tired. NOHAI tracked on the inside, chased inside on the turn and tired. SIRANI stalked three wide, chased and gave way. A Jockey Objection by the rider of AMATERASU against the winner was dismissed.
