PUT THE CRAZY AWAY was bumped at the start, raced off the pace, saved ground on the turn, came three wide into the lane, rallied outside, dueled through the final furlong, dug in gamely and prevailed late. TEMPTING LADY was bumped at the start, raced off the pace inside, advanced inside on the turn, angled out at the top of the lane, rallied between rivals, dueled and dug in gamely to the finish. RINGER CARD showed good early speed to set the pace, dug in gamely inside passing the furlong marker and dueled to the finish. EQUUS raced off the pace, came wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. PRINCESS KALAMOH was bumped at the start, tracked the pacesetter, chased on the turn, came four wide into the lane and tired. TELEPHONE LINE raced off the rail, off the pace, chased on the turn and gave way. A Jockey Objection by the rider of TEMPTING LADY against the winner concerning the start, was dismissed.
