NUEDORF sprinted clear inside, opened long lead in the stretch and prevailed handily. THREE CAPTAINS sluggish early, advanced on the turn and closed well while no match for the winner. FROST MOUNTAIN raced five wide just off the pacesetter and weakened. ENFORCER stumbled at the start, rushed to contention then faltered. TUFF CONSTITUTION was urged behind wall of rivals, moved wide and lacked a rally. BIG BROWN SHOES prompted the pace along the rial to the stretch and faded. CANTARO dropped far behind then passed fading rivals. NO NO JOE broke slowly and was never in contention. COBBLE ROAD moved close up wide between rivals and gave way. CURLINS CRUZIN prompted the pace between foes in the two path and stopped. OMAHA EIGHT lacked speed and weakened steadily.
