REE NEE'S SIX controlled the pace, widened on the final turn and maintained a long advantage while ridden out. MORE RANSOM stalked the pace three wide and closed well to gain the place. ROMAN GODDESS prompted the winner outside for three quarters and weakened. GOLDCREST rated close up between rivals then flattened out in the stretch. CLASSY MISS angled inside early, bid closer before half mile then faded. AMY MULE lagged far behind early inside and lacked a response. STELLA MARS dropped back after the start and gave way readily.
