NIXON JOY (ARG) trailed on the inside, advanced three wide into the stretch, commenced a late rally farthest outside, surged in deep stretch and was up in the final strides for the win. NEW COMMISSION raced off the rail, off the pace, advanced on the far turn, went four wide past the quarter pole, rallied four wide in the stretch drive, dueled, dug in gamely to the finish and earned the place spot. COACH KNIGHT set the pace on the inside, dueled on the far turn, dug in gamely inside, dueled in the stretch drive while drifting out through the final furlong and bumping KEITHSENDSHELLOOOO nearing the wire. KEITHSENDSHELLOOOO stalked two wide, bid between rivals on the far turn, dueled, dug in gamely through the stretch drive, dueled to the finish and was bumped nearing the wire. AHSAD steadied twice in the early stages, then stalked three wide, bid three wide on the far turn, dueled three wide through the stretch run, dug in gamely and steadied in tight nearing the finish. WHAT A BLAST tracked on the inside, chased inside on the far turn and faded. After a Stewards' Inquiry and Jockey Objections by the riders of AHSAD and KEITHSENDSHELLOOOO against the third place finisher, COACH KNIGHT was disqualified and placed fifth.
