LIGHT MY WAY vied inside for the lead, dueled into the far turn, shook free nearing the quarter pole, then dug in gamely on the rail in the final furlong and held on for the win. GOTTA GUY pulled early and was steadied in tight on the clubhouse turn, then raced off the pace with an inside trip, advanced inside on the far turn, angled out at the eighth pole, rallied, made a late bid to the wire. MORETHANAFEELING vied outside for the lead, dueled with the winner, then chased that rival, dug in through the lane and earned the show spot. BOYS OF SUMMER stalked close up outside rivals, chased four wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. ATROCIOUS tracked the pace on the inside, moved up on the backside, chased three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. EL CORDOBES raced two wide off the pace, chased between rivals on the far turn, lacked a rally and finished evenly.
