TRANSCENDENTAL shook loose early then eagerly widened through the stretch under moderate urging. H C HOLIDAY chased between rivals then closed well outside for the place while no threat to the winner. POWER AGENDA saved ground close up then flattened out in the stretch. IMAGINIZED broke sluggishly, raced three wide and continued willingly. SHOULDHAVEBEENGONE prompted the pace outside for half mile and retreated. FIRST MONEY saved ground behind the leaders and weakened steadily. OMAHA EIGHT broke sluggishly, saved ground and lacked any response. BACK EAST dropped back early and was always outrun.
