PONTIFFANY vied outside for the early lead, then chased, rallied inside in the stretch run, gained command at the sixteenth marker, edged away, dug in late and held on for the win. GOLDIENESS was bumped at the start, tracked on the inside, was in tight on the rail entering the turn, rallied outside in the stretch, angled in behind MAGGIE MISCHIEF in midstretch, closed late and was gaining. MAGGIE MISCHIEF was reluctant loading, showed good early speed to set the pace, opened up on the turn, drifted out in midstretch and tired. CLOUT CHASER raced off the pace inside, chased on the turn and had no rally. ROLLS ROYCE JOYCE was bumped at the start, raced off the pace, chased on the turn and failed to threaten. MO'S VINO MESA was bumped on both sides at the start and checked back, then raced off the pace and was outrun.
