AD MAJORA rated inside, angled out and went after the winner on the final turn and proved easily second best. LORDEN'S PRIDE hustled to the front inside, led for half mile then weakened. LUCKY CAPO saved ground off the pace then flattened out in the stretch. THOMAS BENJAMIN moved close up in the two path then faded on the final turn. TOP OF D AGENDA lagged far behind then caught stopping rivals. UR HONEY moved close up just off the inside early then gave way readily. BUTTER MAN was put to urging into the far turn but had no response.
