AWESOME PAL prompted the pace outside and continued willingly to the finish. SCINTILLATING STAR saved ground close up and raced evenly through the stretch. GIA'S FUEGO was urged just off the leaders, drifted in stretch and continued well. MORE RANSOM lacked speed, moved wide in the stretch with some late energy. AFLEET DIVA controlled the pace to the final furlong and weakened. MS. MALEVOLENCE dropped back early and was never in contention. BOSS CARA trailed most of the trip and caught fading rival late. SEVEN YEARS LATER offered four wide bid on the turn then stopped in the stretch.
