LIBERTY STAR controlled the pace, was collared in the stretch then held rivals safe under steady urging. CHINESEIAM saved ground throughout, bid on the turn, loomed a threat but could not get by the winner. TWENTYEIGHTTOTHREE outrun early, angled out in the stretch then made a gradual gain. MY KID SYD eased back early, advanced inside and passed tiring rivals. TOJO'S MOJO prompted the pace three wide then proved empty in the stretch. COBBLE ROAD dropped back early, raced very wide and was no factor. INMORTAL J lagged far behind throughout. BIAGIO prompted the pace outside for half mile and gave way.
