THE TIRE MAN broke slowest, rushed to the front inside, moved clear in midf-stretch and lasted under a drive. WILL'S MUSIC trailed for half mile, advanced inside and the narrowed gap too late. PASTERO lacked speed inside, angled very wide on the turn and rallied strongly. TIZTIMONIAL raced off the pace in the two path and continued willingly. BRENTWOOD flashed speed three wide to the stretch and faltered. WEEK'S STRONG bid closer four wide on the turn then faded. ESSENTIALLY FAST prompted the pace near the inside and faltered. SHOULDWOODACOULDA earned narrow advantage early then stopped after half a mile.
