ROAN BURGUNDY vied inside to the final furlong; drifted out in the stretch and lasted in a game score. WALK AWAY JOE dropped far behind then rallied wide with good late energy. TWENTYEIGHTTOTHREE trailed for three quarters then closed well inside. PRAETORIAN GUARD stalked the pacesetters four wide, angled in stretch, steadied slightly late. KICK STARTNESS vied three wide with narrow advantage then weakened late. YOUTEBETTERBEJOKING dueled between rivals to the final furlong, steadied slightly and faded. The stewards posted an inquiry into the stretch run of the race. The rider of the second finisher claimed foul against the winner for late interference. The rider of the fourth finisher claimed foul against the third finisher for stretch interference. The objections were denied and the result was allowed to stand.
