BOOTLEG RUNNER quickly took control, widened in the stretch and was never menaced while ridden out. HEPHEPCUTDOWNNETS pursued the winner throughout and was easily second best while no threat to the winner. WHOOSH dropped far behind then passed rivals without menacing. WILL'S MUSIC lagged far behind then caught stopping rivals. FASTIDIOUS was urged close up outside then gave way on the turn. MUNYHUNGRY raced wide off the leaders and stopped abruptly. DAVID'S KITTEN lacked speed and gave way readily.
