COACH CLINT firmly rated, bid inside on the final turn, rallied clear and remained safe driving. CENTAUR CENTRAL close up inside, faded after half mile then came again in the stretch. VINO DOMINUS settled off the pace three wide and continued willingly. EASTER BLESSING alternated for the advantage in the two path then inside and weakened in the stretch. TIZ THE COAST prompted the pace outside for three quarters and faltered. WILL'S MUSIC lagged far behind, moved inside on the final turn and was no factor. TIZTIMONIAL dropped far behind then passed fading rivals very wide. THOMAS BENJAMIN flashed speed inside to the far turn and stopped. MUNYHUNGRY lacked speed and weakened steadily.
