SOLO IN PARIS saved ground early, bid on the turn, angled out in the stretch, rallied and edged off. KING DEIVYS sluggish early, rallied on the turn and finished well. RIGHT WING RUNNER sprinted away early, widened on the turn then shortened stride in the final furlong. BIZ WHIZ stumbled badly at the start then advanced inside. TEN PLUS TEN chased off the pace and was never involved. GLOBAL STEVE raced in closest pursuit of the pacesetter and faded after half. J CODY flashed speed initial quarter mile then drifted out fading. TROTSKY injured himself in the starting gate and was ordered a late scratch.
