BOCA ROYALTY forced the pace outside, took over midway on the turn and edged off under a brisk hand ride. DREAM CHASER hustled to the front inside, lost the lead on the turn and continued willingly to the wire. CREME CARAMEL settled inside the dueling leaders and lasted for the show. FROSTED DIAMOND lacked speed inside and rallied mildly in the stretch. SIRENETTA moved close up in the two path and weakened slightly. ANGELIC STORM dropped back wide and gave way readily.
