BATTLE ANTHEM broke outwardly a bit, was coaxed forward inside, tracked the leader saving ground on the turn, tipped out in upper stretch for room, rallied between foes near the sixteenth pole to take the lead soon after, edged just clear and held. POSSUM broke just a hair awkwardly, settled into stride off the pace, advanced steadily outside foes into and on the turn racing three to five deep, came into upper stretch six deep, kept on grinding outside to get up for place late. SUMMONYOURCOURAGE bobbled outwardly a bit at the start, was still away quickly and in pursuit from outside, went three to four wide on the turn just off the leader, asked passing the quarter pole, came into upper stretch five deep with aim, struck a brief lead past the furlong marker but was outfinished and lost place late. GLOBAL STEVE was reluctant to load, chased from off the inside, shifted in toward the rail in upper stretch, ran on evenly. RIGHT WING RUNNER was urged at the start and quickly made the lead and edged clear, set the pace from just off the rail, came out a bit in upper stretch, weakened late. EXTRASEXYMCSTEEMEE was forced out just slightly at the start, settled at the rear shifting in heading to the turn, saved ground on that bend, carried on along the inside to improve position while gaining late. UP THE KINGDOM was carried in a bit early chasing close up to the lead, steadily

dropped back inside, came out in the stretch, was not a late threat. COACH CLINT switched out off the rail heading up the backstretch racing toward the rear, went in the two path through the turn, swung four to five wide for the stretch run, failed to menace. CHUBASCO SAUCE lacked early speed racing outside at the rear into the turn, went three to four deep on that bend, came out seven wide in the stretch, was never near enough to threaten. STINGER BEE bobbed ever so slightly at the start, chased from mid-pack off the inside, was between foes heading into the turn, continued in the three to four path on that bend swinging seven wide into upper stretch, dropped back and faded.
